

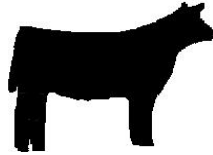

Show Schedule:

- 7:00 a.m. Barns open
- 8:00 – 9:00 a.m. Market (Steer & Heifer) weigh in and heifer check in Barn 1
- 10:00 a.m. Beef Show (Showmanship, Breeding heifers, Market Steers & Heifers)
- 10:00-11:00 a.m. Goat and Sheep check-in & Scales open
- 11:00 a.m. All entries with weights and tag numbers turned in for sheep and goats by exhibitor.
The Sheep show will begin 30 minutes following the beef show.
Show order will be showmanship, followed by weight classes.
The Goat show will follow the sheep show.
Show order will be showmanship, followed by weight classes.

General Rules:

1. The show is open to any bonafide 4-H and FFA member.
 2. Entry fee (per head) is \$15.00 for Beef and \$5.00 for Sheep and Meat Goats.
After May 14, 2010 the entry fee (per head) is \$20.00 for Beef and \$10.00 for Sheep and Meat Goats.
 3. Each exhibitor must provide own supplies and bedding.
 4. Exhibitors must be present to show their animal(s).
 5. All animals must be stalled in the barns or exhibitor must clean outside area used.
 6. No goats or sheep are to be unloaded until goat and sheep check in, 10 a.m. to 11a.m. Show management will inspect for infectious or contagious diseases. Animals showing any signs will be reloaded. No questions asked.
 7. All animals must have an identification ear tag in their ear. Sheep and Goats must also have scrapies tags.
 8. Showmanship classes free to all who pay entry fee, classes are: Peewee (6 and under for Sheep and Goats only), Sr. 14-19, Int. 10-13, Jr. 7-9.
 9. The decision of the judge is final. Protests for any reason must be submitted in writing and accompanied by a \$100.00 fee.
 10. No Clipping on the grounds.
 11. Goats and sheep must be shown with all four feet on the ground.
 12. 1st and 2nd place sheep and goats will be weighed at the conclusion of each class. Those weighing 5 lbs over stated weight will be disqualified.
 13. There will be NO breeding classes for sheep or goats.
 14. Individuals mishandling animals will be asked to leave the show and forfeit any entry/prize money.

Goats

1. If horned, must be tipped (diameter of dime or larger).
2. No artificial coloring, paints, or powders will be permitted.
3. Must be clipped, above the hocks and knees, a maximum of 3/8" hair length.

Sheep

1. All lambs must be slick shorn upon arrival.
2. There will be a maximum weight limit of 125 lbs. for the champion drive.

Beef

1. A minimum of 3 animals per breed required for breed class; otherwise they will be entered into the AOB class.
2. Steers must have appropriate papers to show in a breed class. Papers must be shown at weigh in.
3. Breeding heifers will be divided by age within a breed. Registration papers required on all except crossbred heifers. Heifers without papers will be shown the crossbred class.
